


Year Two Weekly Summary

Week beginning 4th June 2018

- In literacy this week we will revisit poetry writing. We will be looking at different styles of poetry in our comprehension, creative writing and in our homework tasks. We will be considering rhyming words and exploring the theme of colour to write our own poems.
- In maths this week we will be learning about fractions; we will recognise, find, name and write halves, thirds and quarters
- In science we will begin a new topic learning about scientists and inventors and how people have benefited from their discoveries. We will start by looking at the Eden Project and build our own mini greenhouse!
- In topic this week we will name different types of map and at least 2 keys features. The children will begin to compare different types of map and sketch a map of the school area.
- In R.E this week we will begin our new topic; 'The Church Is Born.'
- In music this half term we are going to continue to rehearse for our end of term assembly. We will be rehearsing songs and practising some of our recorder music to play at this event in our lessons.
- In P.E this week we will be working on tennis skills as well as preparing for sports day.
- In computing this term we will revise some of skills we have learnt this year. We will open software for creating computer art. We will control the mouse to produce different effects (dots / lines). We will reproduce an image using a particular artistic style.



Ways to help your child:

- Continue to listen to them read every night or ask them about key features of their reading book when they write their book review.
- Help your child to rehearse their spellings for the test at the end of the week.
- Ask questions about the characters, plot and setting to check their understanding. You could select words from the page to ensure their understanding of the vocabulary they are encountering.
- Encourage your child to focus on their homework tasks to the best of their ability, presenting it to a high standard and proofreading their work to check for errors or opportunities for improvement.
- Practise the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables' division and multiplication facts for the test on Friday. The test will involve the children applying these facts to solve word problems.

Welcome back to the last five weeks of the school year! It has flown by and this half term is about celebrating your child's achievements and preparing them for a more independent approach to learning when they go into year 3.

Please can we ask you to provide your child with their own water bottle so that they can help themselves to water when needed.

We also encourage them to have a sunhat and to have sun cream applied before coming to school each day to keep them safe when playing or working outside.

Finally, in preparation for the end-of-year photo book, please can you email a baby photograph of your child by the end of the week.
