


Year Two Weekly Summary

Week beginning 17th April 2018

- In literacy this week the children will write an independent story focusing on the use of expanded noun phrases. We will continue our learning of different types of sentences (command, exclamation, statement and questions). We will carry out comprehension tasks and focus on retrieving information and making inferences.
- In maths this week we will be focusing on word problems. We will revisit bar modeling and the children will use bar models as a visual tool to facilitate them in solving word problems
- Our science lesson will be next Monday.
- In topic this term we will learn about Travel and Transport and how this has changed over time. We will talk about the different ways we travel to holiday destinations and begin to explore how transport has changed over time.
- In R.E this week we will begin our 'Eastertide' topic by learning about when Jesus appeared to Peter and the other disciples after His resurrection.
- In music this week will review the notes and musical notation learnt before Easter.
- In P.E this term we will be working on striking and fielding as well as preparing for sports day.
- In computing this half term the children will use simple Turtle Logo commands to create a shape using the Turtle Programme.



Ways to help your child:

- Listen to them read every night or ask them about key features of their reading book when they write their book review.
- Ask questions about the characters, plot and setting to check their understanding. You could select words from the page to ensure their understanding of the vocabulary they are encountering.
- Encourage your child to focus on their homework tasks to the best of their ability, presenting it to a high standard and proof-reading their work to check for errors or opportunities for improvement.
- Practise their spellings with them. The test will be done in class on Thursday morning. Please also remind them to use capital letters and full stops whenever they write sentences.
- Practise the 2 times tables division and multiplication facts for the test on Friday. The test will involve the children applying these facts to solve word problems.
