




# Year Two Weekly Summary

Week beginning 25<sup>th</sup> June 2018

- In literacy this week we will continue working on our own stories. We will focus on verbs and punctuation. We will also practise handwriting as well as learning Year 2 spellings for a test on Thursday.
- In maths this week we will be solving word problems and finding fractions of a set.
- In science this week we will complete our investigation into how germs might be spread and learn how to wash our hands effectively to minimize the risk of infection.
- In topic this week we will use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognize landmarks and basic human and physical features. We will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment in the context of aerial photographs.
- In R.E this week we will continue to learn about the ways in which God worked miracles through the apostles.
- In music this week we are going to continue to rehearse for our end of term assembly. We will be playing Hot Cross Buns and Joe Joe.
- In P.E this week we will be working on tennis skills as well as preparing for sports day.
- In computing this week we will use Word to practice our word processing skills and summarise what we have enjoyed most about Year 2.

Ways to help your child:

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- Continue to listen to them read every night or ask them about key features of their reading book when they write their book review.
  - Help your child to rehearse their spellings for the test at the end of the week.
  - Ask questions about the characters, plot and setting to check their understanding. You could select words from the page to ensure their understanding of the vocabulary they are encountering.
  - Encourage your child to focus on their homework tasks to the best of their ability, presenting it to a high standard and proofreading their work to check for errors or opportunities for improvement.
