


Year Two Weekly Summary

Week beginning 26th February 2018

- In literacy this week the children will continue to listen and respond to a range of poems in different ways. They will explore poetic language and use similes and expanded noun phrases in their writing. They will write Spring shape poems and read them aloud in class.
- In maths this week we will be learning about pictograms. The children will read and interpret a pictogram with a scale of 1:1, and a scale of 1:2 or more. We will be reviewing our 11x table.
- In science this week the children will explore the properties of corn flour slime.
- In topic lessons we will locate the 7 continents of the world and name the major oceans of the World.
- In R.E this week we will discuss what happens at the beginning of Mass, the importance of making the sign of the cross and genuflecting when we go into church.
- In Music this week we will continue to practice notes g, b, a and e and we will play the elephant song.
- In P.E this term we will be working on hockey, tag rugby and fitness.
- In Computing lessons we will start our topic on presentation skills and we will create a powerpoint about our topic Around the World. We will revisit logging on, opening a power point, saving and retrieving a document.



Ways to help your child:

- Listen to them read every night and ask questions about the characters, plot and setting to check their understanding. What can they **find out** from the text? What can they **work out** from the text? You could select words from the page to ensure their understanding of the vocabulary they are encountering.
- The weekly spelling test will be done on Thursday morning. Please also remind them to use capital letters and full stops whenever they write sentences.
- Please practise the 11x table tables for the children's tables test on Friday.

We will be celebrating World Book day on Thursday 1st March. Children are encouraged to come to school dressed as a character from their favourite story book together with the book. We also ask for a donation of £1 to go towards the school library.

We will be having shared reading sessions with the older Prep children coming to read with the Pre-prep children. There will also be a story writing competition with a small prize for the winners. It promises to be a very exciting, fun-filled day!
